

Dickens Dressing Table

This page is the home of the shapes that relate to the dressing table and lighting. Of course the most prominent item in this category is Royal Doulton's Pelican Dressing Table set. This page is also the home of Lamp's, Candlesticks and Chamber Sticks. While it is never going to be the largest category, it really is quite interesting as these items are quite hard to find, and often the shapes are quite striking. A good example of this is the Dutch Candlestick.

Royal Doulton Dickens Ware Items from the Dressing Table Pelican Trinket Set

The Pelican Trinket Set consists of a Tray, two candlesticks, a pin tray, a puff box, pomade box and a powder box. To date I have only ever seen one intact Trinket Set; if you have one don't split it up, sell it as one lot. Pelican Pomade Box & Powder Box

Royal Doulton Dickens Ware Mr Micawber; D2973 production era 1908 to 1931 9 cm (3.6") across and 5 cm (2") tall As far as I have been able to make out the Pomade Box and the Powder Box are the same. A Pelican Dressing Table Set consists of a Pomade and a Powder box, but they seem to be identical.

Pelican Puff Box Royal Doulton Dickens Ware Mr Micawber; D2973 production era 1908 to 1931 9 cm (3.6") across and 10 cm (4") tall You will note the the lids on the above two boxes vary, one is decorated with stars while the other has fine filligree work. Set of Pelican Candlesticks

Pelican Pin Tray Royal Doulton Pelican Pin Tray; D2947 production era 1908 to 1931 13.7 cm (5.25") by 8.5 cm (3.5")

The other Dickens Ware items for the dressing table are a Hair Tidy, Hat Pin Stand and a couple of Candlesticks. Hat Pin Stand Royal Doulton Dickens Ware Tony Weller Hat Pin Stand; D2973 production era 1908 to 1931 15 cm (6") tall Hair Tidy Bill Sykes; D2973; production era 1908 to 1931 10 cm (4") tall Lamps, Candlesticks & Chamber Sticks Dutch Candlestick The Artful Dodger; D2973; 1908 to 1931 era 15 cm (6") diameter & 7.5 cm (3") tall

Chamber Stick - Shape 7054 Pair of Dickens Ware Chamber Sticks - Shape 7054 Royal Doulton Dickens Ware Old Peggotty Chamber Stick; D2973 Production era 1908 to 1931 25.5 cm (10") tall Chamber Stick - Shape 7227 Royal Doulton Dickens Ware Mr Micawber Candle Stick; D2973 Production era 1908 to 1931 16 cm (6.35") tall Chamber Stick

Bill Sykes - no other details Candle Sticks - Pewter Royal Doulton Dickens Ware Artful dogger & Bull Sykes Candle Sticks; D2973 18 cm (7.12") tall I don't think these came out of the Royal Doulton Factory like this, I have never seen pewter used by Royal Doulton. On close inspection they appear to be 2 Dickens Ware mustard pots with the pewter work added later. These were purchased out of the US, so I would suggest that this pewter work may even have been done in the US. Lamp Base - Shape 8145 Royal Doulton Dickens Ware Mr Micawber Lamp Base; D5175 Production era 1931 to 1951 28 cm (11") tall Lamp Base - Shape 8149 Royal Doulton Dickens Ware Mr Pickwick Lamp Base; D5175 Production era 1931 to 1951 31 cm (12.2") tall The photo below shows both of the above lamp bases side by side for comparison
