

R.D. Fox Hunting "B"

Royal Doulton's Fox Hunting "B" series is a sibling of Fox Hunting "A" series. They are so closely aligned that very often the scenes from A series and the B series appear together on Bridge sets. However as Fox Hunting B has its own pattern numbers and it is distinctive I will give it its own Fact File page. Royal Doulton's Fox Hunting "B" series is a sibling of Fox Hunting "A" series. They are so closely aligned that very often the scenes from A series and the B series will appear together on Bridge sets. The six Hound & Fox scenes as they appear on Bridge Set Inserts

The only other shape that Fox Hunting "B" seems to appear on is an Lemonade Jug and Mug that are done in relief. Often the Jug also has a scene from English Cottages on it. Royal Doulton Fox Hunting B Lemonade Jug with R.D. English Cottages Scene 5

Fox Hunting B comes on both Bone China and an Earthen Ware ground. At this stage I do not know what the Bone China pattern number is. There are three pattern numbers set against this series for the Earthen Ware ground.

The Earthen Ware pattern numbers are:- D5595 introduced 1935

D5656 introduced 1936

D5909 introduced 1938 To date I have never seen an item decorated with Fox Hunting "B" that I could date to later than 1940. so without further information I must conclude that Fox Hunting "B" was only in production from 1935 until 1940.
